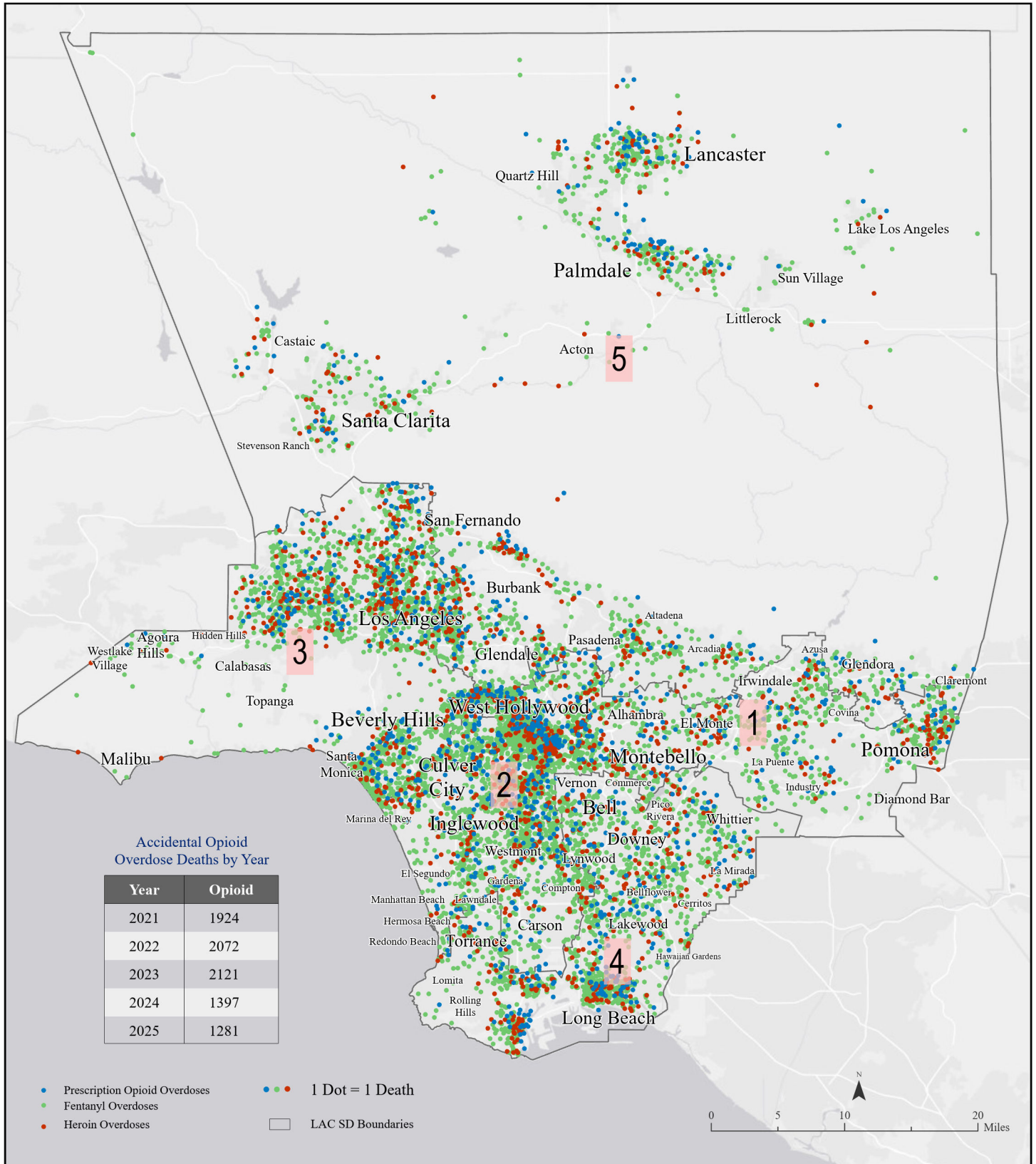


Accidental Opioid Overdose Deaths by SD Los Angeles County, 2021 - 2025.

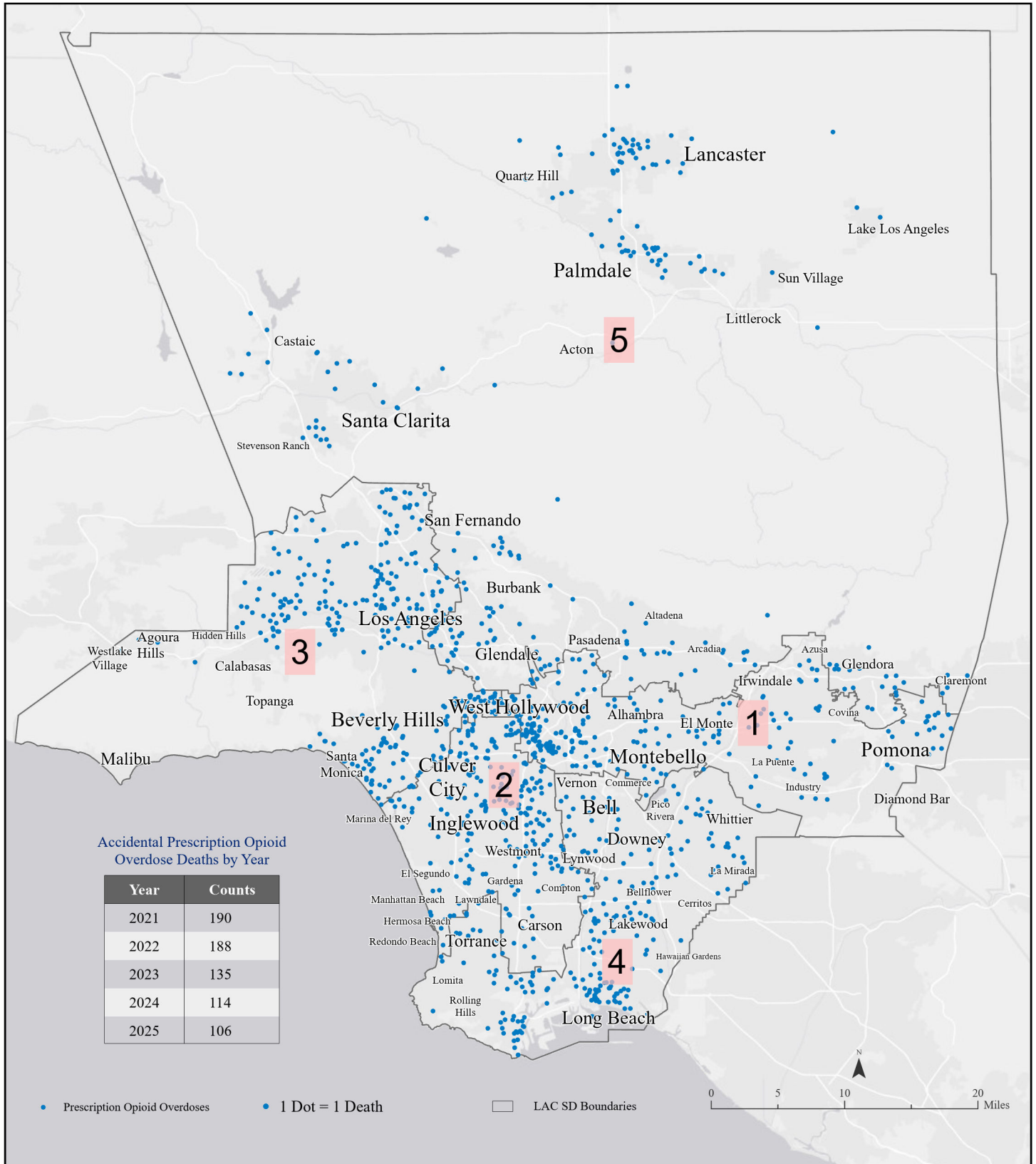

Accidental Prescription Opioid Overdose Deaths by SD Los Angeles County, 2021 - 2025.

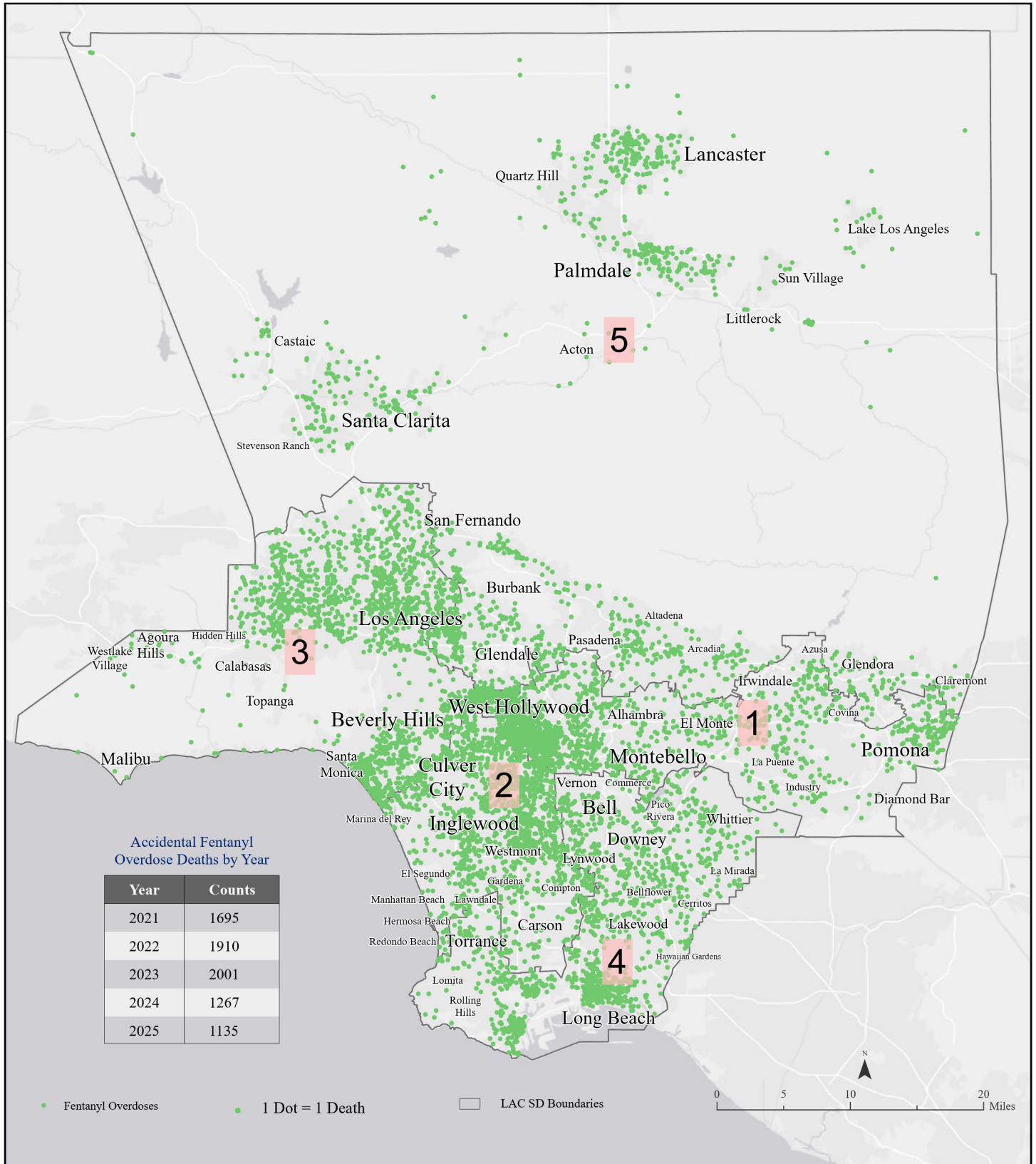

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Accidental Fentanyl Overdose Deaths by SD Los Angeles County, 2021 - 2025.

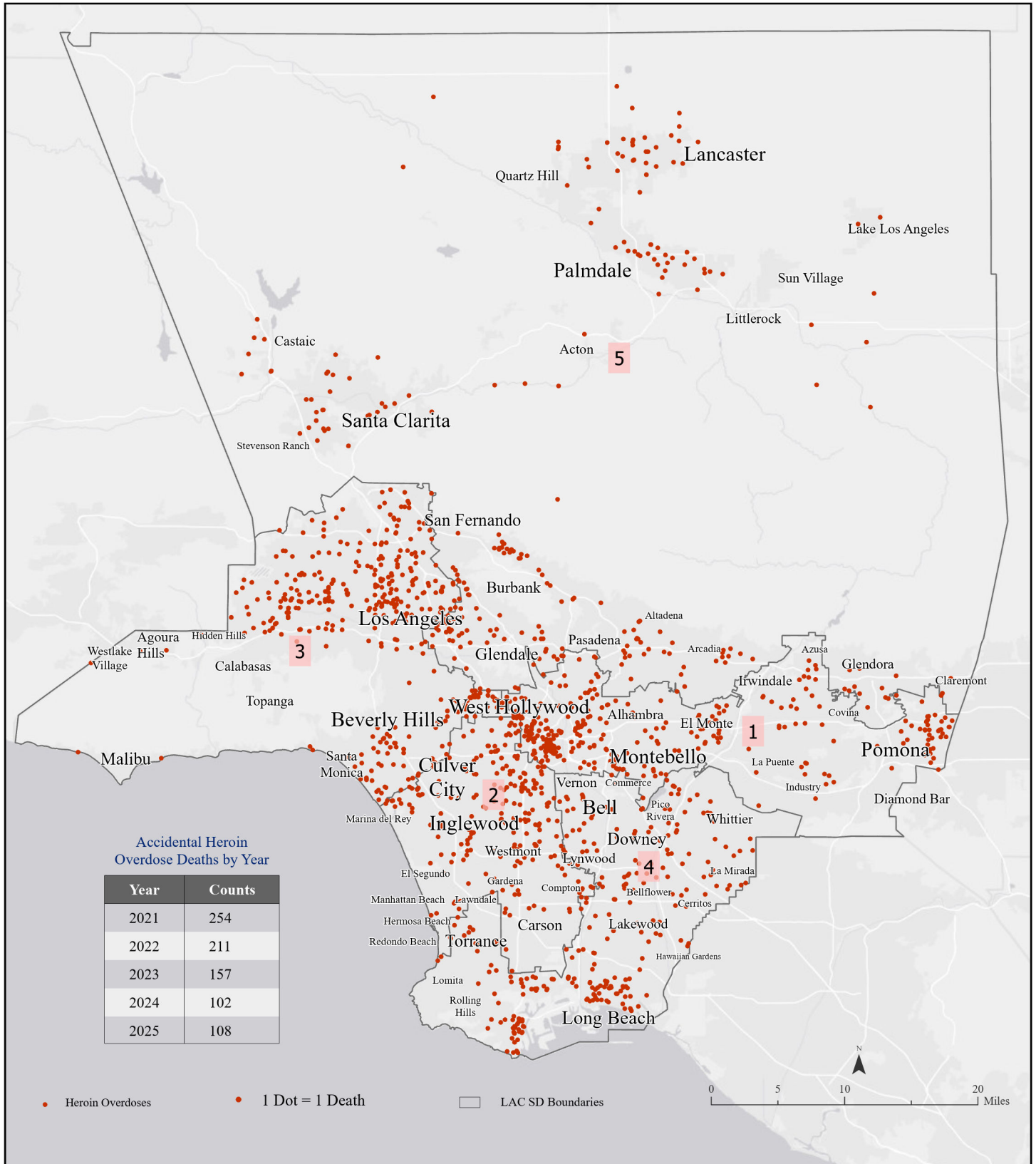

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Accidental Heroin Overdose Deaths by SD Los Angeles County, 2021 - 2025.

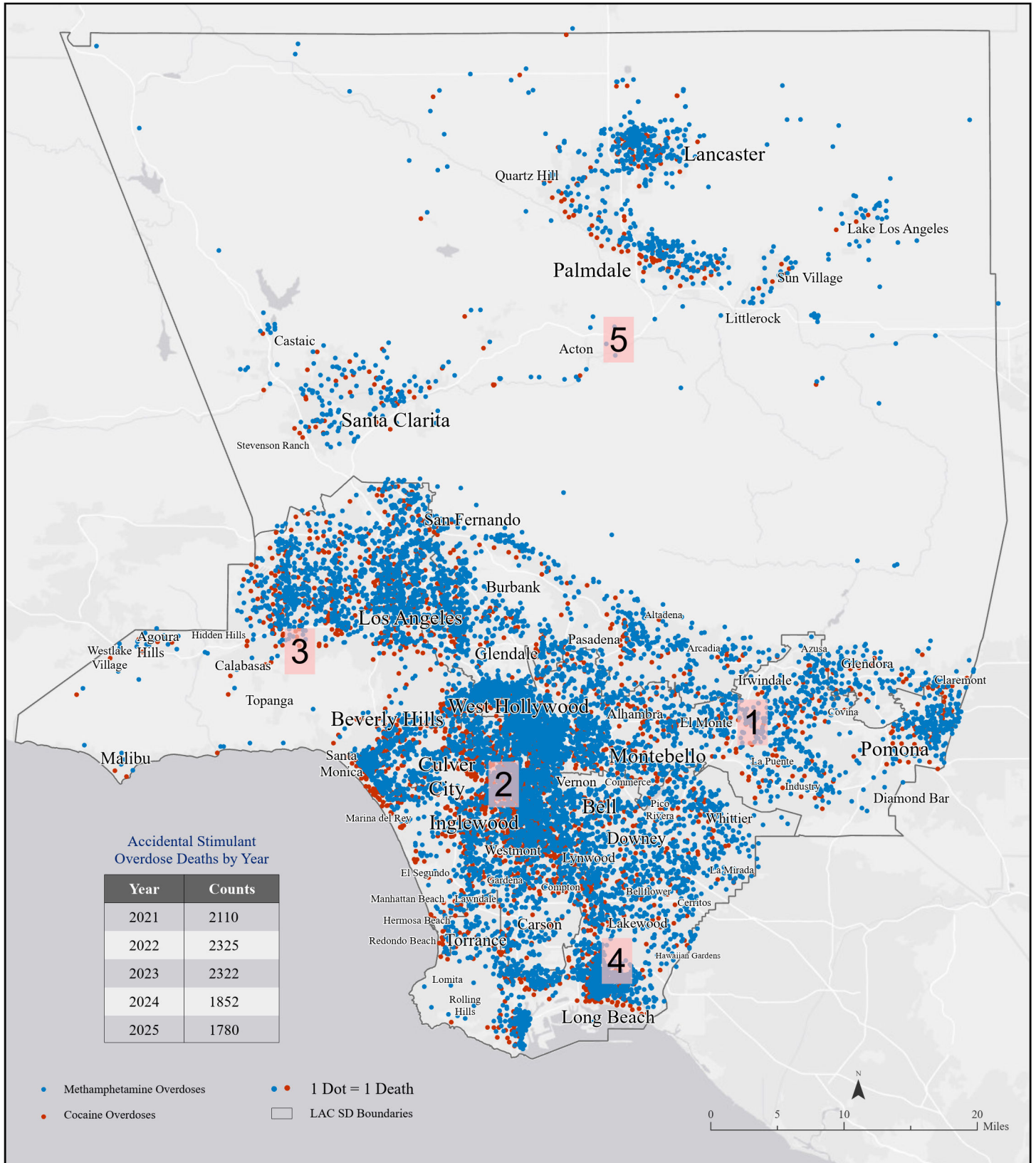

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Accidental Stimulant Overdose Deaths by SD Los Angeles County, 2021 - 2025.

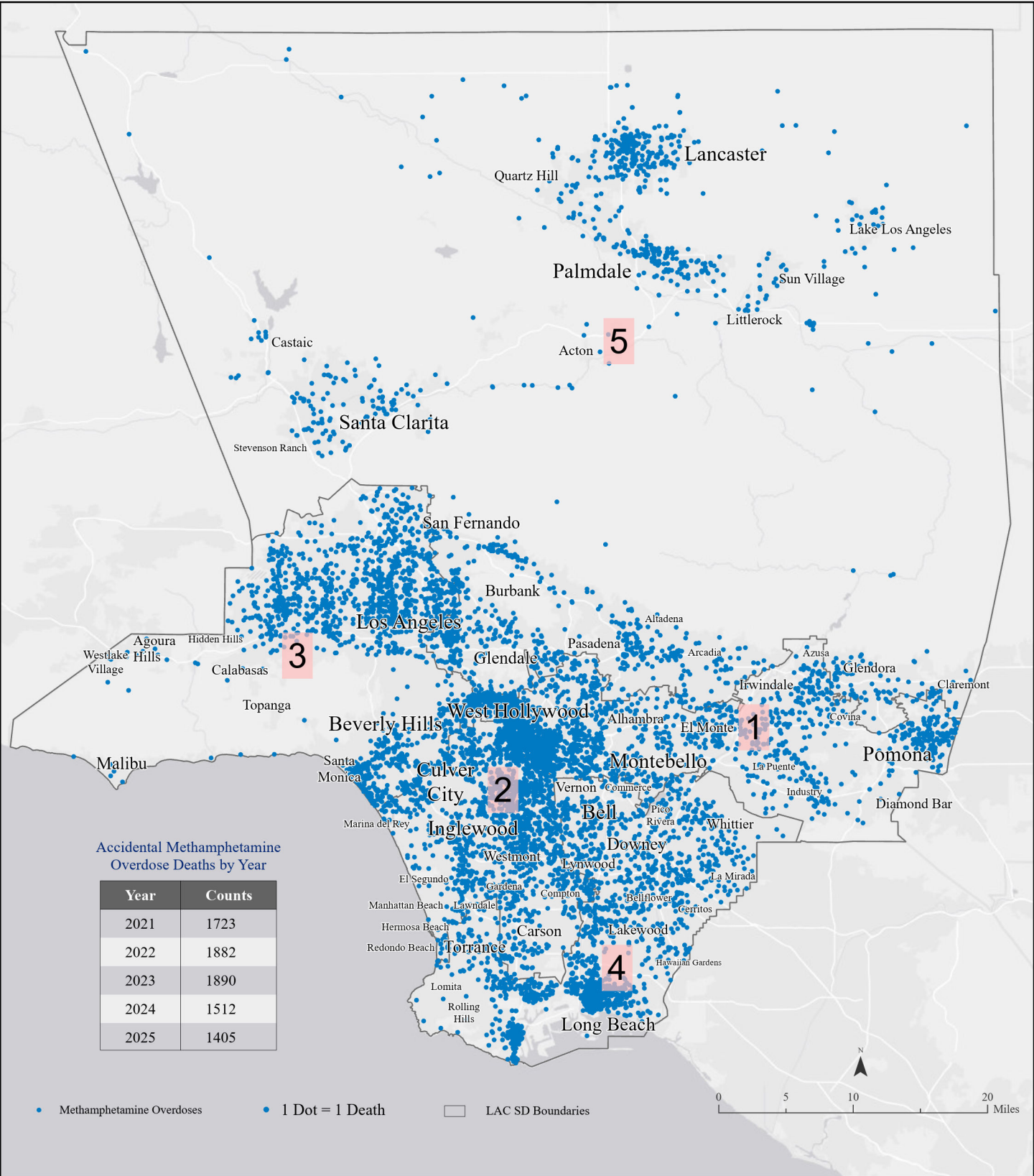

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Accidental Methamphetamine Overdose Deaths by SD Los Angeles County, 2021 - 2025.

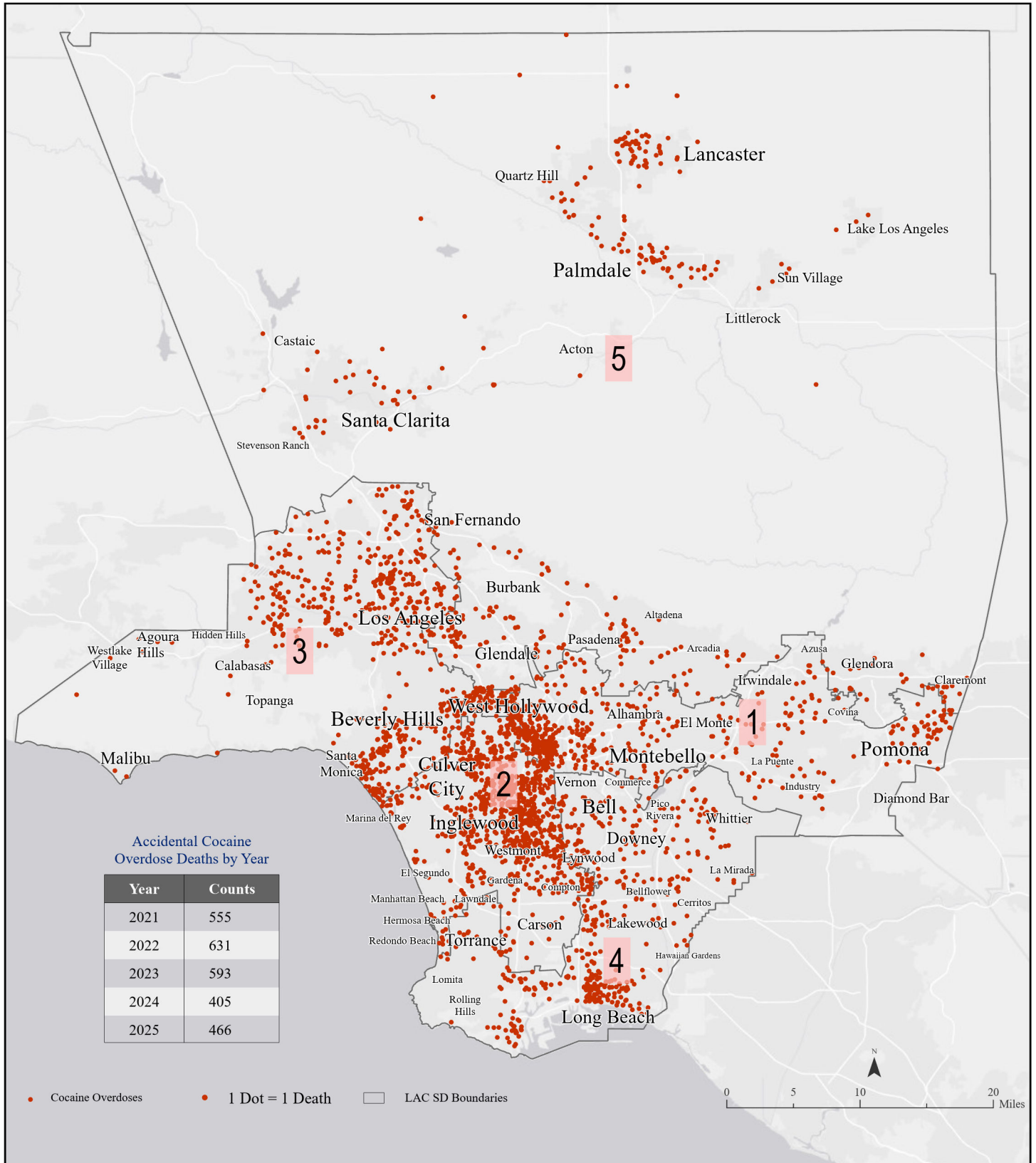
